








# Step 1: Go to your Request a Payment tab

Log in to your account, click **Receive and** select **Request a Payment.** 








# Step 2: Add your Payer details

Click "**Add New Payer**" and input your Client/Payer's details. It will be saved so next time you choose which Payer you will send the request to.



#### PRO TIP:


- When adding your Payer details, please double check with the Payer first if they will be using the credit card under their name or company name.
- Mismatch with credit card or bank details info and Payer details may result to verification of the Payer's identity as part of our Anti-Money laundering and Counter Terrorism Financing Laws.






### Step 3 : Confirm Payment details

Input the **Currency, Amount, Description, Due Date** (for auto reminders) and **Request Payment As** (This is your name / business name that will appear when your Client receives the request). You can attach extra documents like invoices, receipts below as needed.





#### PRO TIP:


 For larger payments over 2,000\$ or equivalent, please attach an official invoice to ensure smoother payments. This is to verify that your payment is for a business transaction.





### Step 4: Submit your Payment Request

Submit the Payment Request to your Client's email. Alternatively, you will also be able to share the unique payment link to your Client via Messenger apps or by copying the direct link. Auto reminders will also be sent to your Client from Payoneer.








# Track your payments



### Payer/Client Step 1: Receive Email/Link and click Pay

Your Client/Payer will receive the payment request to their email or via the link you shared. Your Client clicks "Pay" and will be redirected to Payoneer's secure payment platform. They click "Pay Now" to proceed.




# Payer/Client Step 2: Check Payer details, Assign Password

Your Client/Payer will see an auto-populated info page as you already indicated his/her details earlier when you sent the Payment Request.

They need to assign a **Password** to automatically create a Payer account, so the next time they pay you, they just need to type in the password to submit the payment.

Creating a Payer account enables your Payer/Client to have a smooth experience for future payments via Payoneer.








# Payer/Client Step 3: Choose your Payment option and who covers the fee

Your Client can select their payment method: Credit Card, ACH Debit(US only) and Local Bank Transfer. The payment options are available depending on their location.

Your Client can choose to cover the fee upon processing the payment.

They Click Next and Pay to proceed.








# Payer/Client Step 4: Enter Card Details and Pay

Your Payer inputs their **Cardholder details, and Billing Address**. They click "Pay X Amount" to submit the payment.

### 1) How will I know that I've been paid?

 You will receive an email notification as soon as your Client pays and again when the payment has been transferred to your Payoneer account

### 2) Who pays the fee for the payment?

- Before completing the payment request process, your Client can select who pays the applicable fee. To avoid any misunderstanding, we suggest you discuss this point with your Client in advance.
- If you are located in a <u>European Economic Area (EEA)</u> country, as of January 13, 2018, in compliance with the European Payment Services Directive (PSD2), the fee will automatically be deducted from your Payoneer account.

### 3) Why do you ask for documentation about my Client?

 We may require documentation to confirm your Client's identity. We do this to keep our community of buyers and sellers safe, and to comply with Anti-Money Laundering and Counter-Terrorism Financing laws.
